## **Program Overview**

Who should attend: This event will be of interest to owners, agents, managers, assistant managers, maintenance personnel and resident service coordinators.

Smoke starts to fill the hallways of your building, firefighters rush in, they are able to contain the fire without any serious damage being done. Once the area is clear police detectives show up at the property. The scene is becoming a lot more involved than a simple stove fire.
