Below, please find two updates from HUD regarding DUNS Number requirements and Office of Multifamily Production Program Fees payments screen changes:

## 1. <u>Reminder: DUNS Number Required on All Voucher Submissions</u>

This is a reminder that effective December 1, 2017, vouchers that do not contain an active Dun & Bradstreet's (DB) Data Numbering System (DUNS) Number will generate a Tenant Rental Assistance Certification System (TRACS) fatal error and will not receive payment until corrected. Attached is the <u>memorandum</u> dated June 2, 2017, that implements the requirement to include the DUNS numbers on all vouchers submitted to Tenant Rental Assistance Certification System (TRACS).

## 2. Pay.gov Changes for Office of Multifamily Production Programs

The Office of Multifamily Production Program Fees payments screen on Pay.gov will change next week to include a set of radio buttons to indicate whether a lender is involved in the transaction, plus two new fields. <u>Fees will not change, nor will any processing be affected. The new fields are informational</u>. Please see the attached operational bulletin for more information.
