

- ☐ Immediate crisis intervention.
- \square It is 24 hours a day/7 days a week.
- **☐** We offer bilingual services.
- **☐** We offer emotional support and grounding techniques.
- \Box It is covered by staff, interns, and volunteers.
- ☐ Community resources.













INDIVIDUAL & GROUP COUNSELING

Individual Counseling

- Psychoeducational counseling.
- Weekly sessions/biweekly.
- We use the empowerment model.



- DV/SA Survivor Group.
- 10-12 participants.
- Meets for 12 weeks virtually.
- Trauma focused.
- Topics such as: Healthy vs
 Unhealthy Relationships, Self Blame, Guilt and Shame, Trauma &
 Emotional Regulation, Self-Esteem,
 Self-Care & Self-Love, Conflict
 Resolution, Resiliency & Support
 Networks
- Empower, support, share, and listen to each other.





CHILD ADVOCACY

- Psychoeducational counseling for children who are survivors of sexual abuse, 4 12 years of age.
- Emotional support and counseling for parents and guardians.
- Assistance with referrals to the Essex Children's Advocacy Center.





Medical Advocacy

- Survivors of sexual assault (24 hours).
- Survivors of DV (9am-5pm).
- Accompany them as long as needed.
- We offer emotional support.
- Lawrence general hospital, Holy Family Hospital (Methuen/Haverhill) (SANE Certified).
- Salem Hospital, Beverly Hospital, Addison Gilbert Hospital, Anna Jaques Hospital
- Evidence collection kit within the first 5 days post assault.
- Police reporting not required unless underage.







Court Advocacy

- No legal representation!!!
- 2 SAFEPLAN advocates-Lawrence District Court, P&F Court.
- 1 SAFEPLAN Advocate-Haverhill District Court
- Bilingual advocates.
- Assist with the completion of restraining and harassment orders.



- Emotional support and accompaniment to the protective order hearing.
- Provide information on legal and safety options.
- Referrals to local support services (counseling services, etc.)





Residential Programs

- <u>Oasis-</u> Housing for women and children who are survivors of domestic violence, need 3rd party verification of domestic violence and homelessness.
- Single Room Occupancy (SRO)- Permanent housing, application process through Lawrence Housing Authority.
- Permanent Supportive Housing- HOH must be disabled referrals come from the EOHLC department.
- Permanent Residents- Referrals come from CTI
- Undisclosed Emergency Shelter.









Assistance with Emergency Shelters

• Statewide hotline service providing information or any open domestic violence shelters.





Educational Outreach

- Presentations to schools, police stations, medical professionals, local agencies, etc.
- Tabling events.
- Provider meetings.
- Professional trainings.
- Community events.









Referrals

- Medical professionals (Licensed social workers, therapists, psychiatrists).
- DTA (Department of Transitional Assistance).
- Lawrence Housing Authority
- Legal aid agencies
- Food pantries
- Local shelters
