## **APPLICABILITY:**

- Government Personnel and Contractors inspecting under REAC management
- Properties subject to REAC UPCS Inspections under these programs:
  - PH programs
  - Projects under 24 CFR Sec.200.853(a)
  - Non-insured properties under Section 236 of NHA with active HAPS, RAP, Rent Supp or IRP contracts.
  - Properties under Sec. 542(b) of the HCDA of 1992 with a Sec.8 contract
  - HUD-held projects

## Background and Rationale

- Achieves a more accurate picture of how the property is being maintained year-round
- Reduces significant costs spent for inspection preparation and promotes reinvestment into the property year-round
- GENERAL CONCEPT
  - Property notified 14 Calendar days before the inspection
  - Unless state or local law requires a longer resident notification window
  - If property cancels/refuses inspection that day the score will be zero
  - One additional reinspection within 7 calendar days; otherwise, score held at zero (the additional day is of the inspector's choosing)
  - Effective March 23, 2019
     Except for inspections procured under a Period of Performance extending beyond this effective date. In those cases inspection notices are issued in accordance with previous guidance.
