How to become a Human Resource Manager

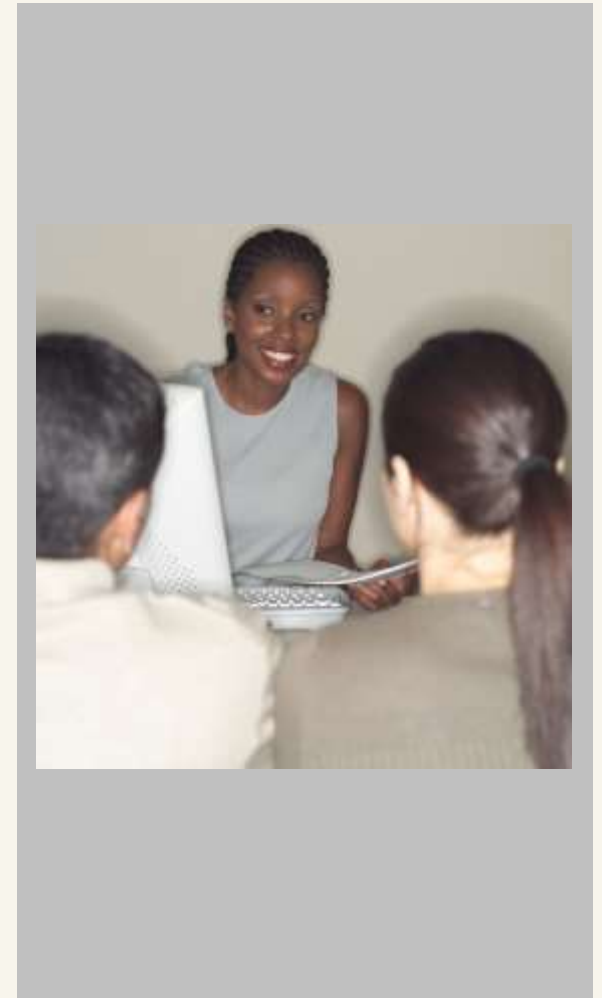
- A combination of education and several years of related work experience are required
