

NAHMA Senior Housing Update: GAO Report on Funding for HUD's Supportive Housing Programs

Dear NAHMA Member,

As required by Congress in fiscal year 2015, The Government Accountability Office (GAO) recently released the report *HOUSING FOR SPECIAL NEEDS: Funding for HUD's Supportive Housing Programs*. The report examines HUD's Section 202, Supportive Housing for the Elderly program and the Section 811, Supportive Housing for Persons with Disabilities program.

In detail, the report highlights (1) how HUD determined the capital advance amounts awarded to sponsors for Section 202 and Section 811 and (2) the number of capital advance awards and amounts by state from fiscal years 2008–2011 and any changes in the distribution of capital advances over that period. The GAO reviewed budget documents and funding announcements and interviewed agency officials, but it does not provide any recommendations in this report.
